Tucson is a colorful city, with eye-catching murals, art, and an incredible desert landscape to make your social media shine. The [Greetings from Tucson Mural](#) is one of the city's most famous murals, while the beautiful [La Pilita Mural](#) dazzles with traditional Mexican and Aztec imagery. Street art in the [Warehouse Arts District](#) is abundant, including the [Goddess of Agave Mural](#), while the [Mercado District](#) is chock-full of rustic and chic photo opps. The beloved [San Xavier de Bac Mission](#) or the Southwest Deco style of the historic [Fox Tucson Theater](#) are sure to bring character to your wall, and the historic [Hotel Congress](#), site of the capture of notorious gangster John Dillinger in 1934, will add drama!

A SHOPPING MECCA

With myriad shopping options, Tucson is the ideal place for a splurge! With more than 100 stores, restaurants, boutiques, bars, clubs, and coffeehouses, the tree-lined [4th Avenue District](#) downtown is the perfect place to shop, eat, and drink the day away, while Tucson's elegant, high-end shopping mecca [La Encantada](#) has all the posh chains you love. You'll find a hip mix of eclectic, utilitarian, and just plain awesome merch at [Mercado San Agustín](#), Tucson's Westside public market. [Bahti Indian Arts](#) sells Navajo, Hopi, and Pueblo textiles, jewelry, and sculptures, and [Mac's Indian Jewelry](#) offers vintage and contemporary jewelry made by tribes in the region, while thrift store [Buffalo Exchange](#) will keep you stylish in past fashion favorites. And don't forget to pick up a Tucson souvenir for the peeps back home at [Native Seeds/SEARCH!](#)

LIBATIONS GALORE

Tucson's craft cocktail culture is on point. Trendy basement bar [Barbata](#) boasts European flair, while [Batch Whiskey & Donuts](#) pairs whiskey with delectable, fresh made donuts (you read that right). [Century Room](#) mixes mezcal and live music in perfect proportions, and [Good Oak Bar](#) combines a cozy atmosphere with whiskey and agave. To sample a 'Lady in Red,' head to [HighWire](#),

or to [Jackrabbit Lounge](#) for a 'Jessica Rabbit.' Hop culture is thriving too. [Tucson Hop Shop](#) has 20 taps flowing, and [Barrio Brewing Co.](#) has seasonal brews. [Arizona Beer House](#) has 35 taps of refreshing Arizona beers, and the lively taproom of [Draagoon Brewing Company](#) is the perfectly inviting. [Ermanos Craft Beer & Wine Bar](#) has a finely curated craft beer list and an extensive selection of wines, while [REVEL](#) wine bar features wines from around the world alongside crafted meat and cheese boards, and [Agustin Kitchen](#) serves reds, whites, and sparkling wines by the glass or bottle. If coffee is your fuel of choice, head to [Black Crown Coffee Co.](#) for a 'Turbo Coke' served by sarcastic baristas, or [Cartel Coffee Roasters](#) for a frothy and funky treat. For cold-pressed juices and shakes to support wellness, check out [Goodness](#) for a 'Daily Buzz,' or 'Hot Tropic.' Or provide your body with the nourishment with a 'Mango Sunrise,' or 'Georgia Peach & Mango con Chile' at [Berry Greens Juice Bar](#).

FOODIE PARADISE

If you're craving red meat, [Silver Saddle Steakhouse](#) (voted Tucson's Best Steakhouse) will not disappoint, while [Fleming's Prime Steakhouse](#) offers prime steaks, seafood, and inventive plant-based alternatives. [Pinnacle Peak](#) serves a mesquite-grilled Cowboy Steak in an Old West, no ties allowed atmosphere, and [Kingfisher Bar & Grill](#) boasts award-winning grilled meats and fresh seafood. For a taste of local BBQ, head to [Kiss of Smoke BBQ](#) and smack down on low and slow cooked meats, or [BrushFire BBQ](#) where meats are smoked over locally sourced mesquite and pecan hardwoods. If sushi is how you roll (har har) check out the scorpion roll and fresh sashimi at [Izumi](#), or visit [Kazoku Sushi](#) where Champong (seafood noodle soup) is a must-try and green tea ice cream is a sweet treat! For seafood, [El Berraco](#) is on point with a Latin-inspired menu, while [Mariscos Chihuahua](#) offers octopus, shrimp, marlin, oysters, scallops, and fan favorite sautéed shrimp in a creamy green sauce. For a memorably delicious Mexican restaurant experience try the Topopo Salad at [Guillermo's Double L](#), or [Maico's Restaurant](#) where fish tacos, menudo and goat birria, carne asada burrito, and ceviche tostada are top tier, or all-around cozy [El Merendero](#) for a sea of daily specials. For Mother Earth approved comfort foods head to [Prep & Pastry](#) for a chickpea scramble with veggies, [Urban Fresh](#) for Irish biscuits in stout gravy, or [Beaut Burger](#) for vegan burgers made with millet, beans, and veggies. And don't forget a vegan peanut butter ganache Rice Krispie treat!
